



RoHS REACH CE UKCA Regulation Compliance Statement

RoHS Regulation Directive 2002/95/EC WEEE Regulation Directive 2012/19/EC



Products covered: All products supplied by Connexion Developments Ltd are RoHS and WEEE compliant unless the product is specifically stated otherwise. This is a general statement – please contact Connexion Developments Ltd if you require a product specific (by part number) declaration.

EU legislation regarding the recycling of waste for electrical and electronic equipment according to the **Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive (WEEE Directive) 2012/19/EU** and the directive implementing restrictions on the use of certain hazardous substances (RoHS 2 Directive) 2011/65/EU superseding directive 2002/95/EC of 27 January 2003 requires CE marking directive and RoHS 3 adds an additional four substances as of July 22, 2019.

Connexion Developments Ltd is aware that under the WEEE directive 13th August 2005 the producer of a product that falls within the definition in the WEEE directive has a number of responsibilities with respect to product design, collection, treatment and recovery.

RoHS now RoHS 2 directives since 1st July 2006, it is not possible to place into the market in the EU certain electronic equipment with value weight by weight exceeding Cadmium (Cd) max 100 ppm, Lead (Pb) max 1000 ppm, Mercury (Hg) Max 1000 ppm, Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI) Max 1000 ppm, Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB) Max 1000 ppm, Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE) Max 1000 ppm, Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) Max 1000 ppm, Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP) Max 1000 ppm, Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) Max 1000 ppm, Diisobutylphthalate (DIBP) Max 1000 ppm (parts per million). The RoHS 2 directive 3rd January 2013 requires CE certification and product marking.

REACH Regulation (EC) 1907/2006



Products Covered: All products supplied by Connexion Developments Ltd are REACH compliant unless the product is specifically stated otherwise. This is a general statement – please contact Connexion Developments Ltd if you require a product specific (by part number) declaration.

REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals, EC 1907/2006) 1st June 2007 is the European Unions (EU) chemical substances regulatory framework. REACH requires Connexion Developments Ltd to provide customers with sufficient information on Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) to the REACH, Annex XIV and Candidate List contained in all products in concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) to allow safe use of the product.

To comply with this requirement, Connexion Developments Ltd certifies that to the best of its knowledge all products supplied do not contain substances listed on the Candidate List of substances of Very High Concern, as updated on 15th January 2018, in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight.

CE marking is mandatory (until 1st January 2021) for any product traded within the single market European Economic Area (EEA) showing that either the manufacturer or importer (if outside of EU) has checked that the products meets EU safety, health or environmental requirements and is an indication of the products compliance with EU legislation and allows for the free movement of products within the European market.

UKCA compliance UK safety, health, and environmental requirements

UKCA (UK Conformity Assessed) marking is a new UK product marking used for goods being placed into the market in Great Britain (England, Wales and Scotland) that covers most goods that previously required CE marking. UKCA marking came into effect 1st January 2021, however the CE marking can still be used until 1st January 2023 in most cases.

Validation Method.

Connexion Developments Ltd gathers declaration statements, letters and certificates from all manufacturers and suppliers to validate that all products supplied conform to various regulatory requirements for REACH, WEEE, RoHS, UKCA and CE.
